



## **Knockaneden Wind Farm**

### **Community Fund Awards - 2016**

#### **Terms and Conditions**

1. These terms and conditions are the Rules ("Rules"), which apply to Knockaneden Community Fund Awards ("Awards") only, unless otherwise expressly stated. By applying, applicants agree to be bound by these Rules.
2. The Knockaneden Community Fund Awards 2016 are organised by Mainstream Renewable Power Limited ("Mainstream") having a trading address at Arena House, Arena Road, Sandyford, Dublin 18.
3. Mainstream reserves the right to cancel or amend the Community Fund Awards, and these Rules at any time without prior notice.
4. In the event of a dispute, the decision of Mainstream shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.

#### **Qualifying Entrants**

5. To qualify to apply for the Knockaneden Community Fund Awards 2016 the organisation/group must be resident within 10km of the Wind Farm.
6. Organisations/groups applying must be not-for-profit. Individuals may not apply in their own right.
7. Any company contractually involved with Mainstream in the development or construction of the wind farm are not eligible to apply.
8. By submitting an application, you hereby warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete.
9. Mainstream reserves the right to disqualify any applicant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the applicant has breached any of these Terms and Conditions.
10. If an applicant is disqualified from the Award, Mainstream in its sole discretion may decide whether a replacement applicant should be selected. In this event, any further applicant will be selected on the same criteria as the original applicant and will be subject to these Rules.

## Award Entries

11. Only one entry per organisation/group per Award is allowed.
12. Proposals will be accepted from all aspects of community life – economic, social, and educational. However, preference will be given to proposals that have an environmental theme and/or are linked to sustainable local activities.
13. All applications must be submitted on an official application form. Failure to do so will disqualify the entry. Application forms are available from Mainstream's website [www.mainstreamrp.com/ireland](http://www.mainstreamrp.com/ireland) or directly from Barry Nelson ([barry.nelson@mainstreamrp.com](mailto:barry.nelson@mainstreamrp.com)).
13. The Closing Date for receipt of completed applications is **Friday 31 October 2016**. Applications received after this date will not be considered.
14. To ensure transparency in allocation of funds, a committee comprised of Mainstream and local community representative(s) will assess each application.
15. This assessment will take place within 2 weeks of the closing date for receipt of entries (up to 14 November). **It is essential that the contact person nominated in the application is available during this period to clarify points raised in the application.**
16. Proof of posting cannot be accepted as proof of delivery.

## Awards

17. Award winner(s)' will be contacted on or before 14 November 2016. Award winner(s)' names may be published on the Mainstream website.
18. In all matters, the decision of the committee shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
19. A total of €9,000, will be available for distribution. No single application will be awarded more than 25% of the funds.
20. 50% of the amount awarded may be paid by cheque to the successful applicant with the balance being paid upon receipt of the required progress reports and updates.
21. Awards are made at Mainstream's discretion and no awards will be made as a result of misrepresentations or illegal acts or omissions by or on behalf of any applicant.

## Intellectual Property Rights

22. You hereby warrant that the information which you submit and/or distribute will not infringe the intellectual property, privacy or any other rights of any third party, and will not contain anything which is libellous, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening. If relevant, Mainstream reserves the right, but not the obligation, to screen, filter and/or monitor information provided by you and to edit, refuse to distribute or remove the same.

## **Liability**

23. Mainstream does not accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any applicant entering the Community Fund Award Scheme or as a result of accepting any award.

## **Data Protection and Publicity**

24. It is a condition of accepting an Award that all winners will agree to co-operate with a reasonable amount of related promotional activity whereby Mainstream may publish winners' names and non-detailed addresses, photographs and audio and/or visual recordings.
25. Any personal data relating to applicants will be used solely in accordance with current data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party without the individual's prior consent.
